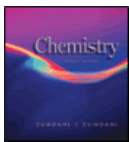


Textbooks, Materials, and Supplies You Will Need for Chem 111B

Please obtain the following by the end of the first week of class:



___ **1. Text book - Chemistry** by Zumdahl 7th edition
(A used copy is acceptable. The study guide is optional; only buy it if you plan on using it. This textbook is not in the library and I cannot by law place it in the library. Sorry.) If this is not on the shelf, it does not necessarily mean they have run out of copies. It might mean they need to re-stock the shelves. Check with bookstore personnel to see if they need to re-stock or anticipated date of arrival. If they run out, [contact me](#) immediately and I will check with them.

___ **2. Lab Manual for Chem 111B** - this is by Joan Lebsack This contains all of the lab experiments, including the Appendix. You will need this immediately. If this is not on the shelf, it does not necessarily mean they have run out of copies. It might mean they need to re-stock the shelves. Check with bookstore personnel to see if they need to re-stock or anticipated date of arrival. If they run out, [contact me](#) immediately and I will check with them.

___ **3. Problem Solving Packet for 111B.** This is also authored by Joan Lebsack.

___ **4. Lab Notebook 5x5 quad** ruled (line ruled comp books are unacceptable). Listed under Quad Comp Books in the Lab Notebook section on the other side of the bookstore.

___ **5. Package of Scantron 882 ES.** You will need at least 5 Scantrons, so might as well get the package.

___ **6. Nonprogrammable calculator** that will perform scientific functions. The TI 30XA at the bookstore is \$13.95 (9.95 for TI 30XA at Staples in Orange) and is the type of calculator you should have. If you have some other nonprogrammable scientific calculator by another company, that's okay. However, if the display is larger than two lines, it is likely a programmable calculator and cannot be used.

___ **7. Safety Goggles for Lab.** You will not be permitted to conduct any lab experiments without your goggles and the form in the Lab Manual signed. Your instructor might give you another date, but you will need the form and the goggles in lab before conducting Expt. 1. If you don't have them, you will be asked to leave lab and you will receive a 0 score for that lab. We do not supply gloves, so if you feel you might be chemical sensitive, bring a pair of gloves. Discuss this with me if you think you might have chemical sensitivities and I will make sure you get the correct type of gloves.

___ **8. Campus Computer Account** We will use computers in 434 A/C, 412, and possibly 901B so you will need to get a campus computer account. These accounts are now automatically assigned to you for the semester when you have paid registration for a course. For more details, please see [Student Computer Accounts](#).



___ **9. Einstruction Classroom Response System** - You will need to set up an account online and enroll in the course. When you purchase the lab manual, there will be an access code for this. You can purchase used clickers at the bookstore.
